Dr. Suketu Khandhar

Neurologist, Kaiser Permanente Sacramento Medical Center, Department of Neurology



I am a neurologist. This means I help to evaluate, diagnose and treat conditions of the brain. I have specialized training in Movement Disorders. Movement Disorders is a sub-specialty of neurology dedicated to Parkinson's disease and related disorders, Essential Tremor, Dystonia, Chorea, Tics, Gait abnormalities and other diseases of abnormal involuntary movements. I am part of a dedicated team of specialists focusing on surgical treatments of Parkinson's disease, Essential Tremor and Dystonia. I also evaluate patients who may benefit from Botulinum toxin injections for various movement disorders. I chose this sub-specialty of neurology because it provided me multiple opportunities to help patients with conditions previously thought not to have many options.

Assistant Clinical Professor of Neurological Surgery
Attending Surgeon, Neurosurgery and Parkinson's Disease Research, Education and Clinical Center, San Francisco Veterans Affairs Hospital and Medical Center
Principal Investigator, Movement Disorders Research

Dr. Larson's clinical interests are in stereotactic and functional neurosurgery, particularly with regard to movement disorders and psychiatric disorders. He has been involved in the development and evolution of novel surgical methods for deep brain stimulator implantation, including frameless techniques and the use of high-field, real-time intraoperative magnetic resonance imaging (MRI). He has extensive surgical experience in the use of intraoperative MRI for a number of neurosurgical applications. During his residency, Dr. Larson was extensively involved in the development of the **Norton Hospital** intraoperative MRI program, and spent a year in the **Speed School of Engineering's Computer Vision and Image Processing Lab** studying the basic science of CT and MR image analysis and 3D modeling.

Nicklesh Thakur, D.O., recently joined **Sutter Neuroscience Medical Group**. Dr. Thakur is board-certified in neurology, fellowship-trained in movement disorders and specializes in deep brain stimulation for Parkinson's disease, essential tremor, and dystonia patients. Dr. Thakur received his degree in Osteopathic Medicine from **Arizona College of Osteopathic Medicine**. He completed his Internal Medicine Internship at **Queens Hospital Center**, New York and his Residency in Neurology at the **University of Texas-Houston Health Science Center**. His Fellowship in Movement Disorders is from **Barrow Neurological Institute** in Phoenix, Arizona. In addition to his medical practice, Dr. Thakur has participated as a co-investigator in clinical research studies relating to movement disorders. He is a member of the **American Academy of Neurology** and the **Movement Disorders Society**.
